Eight \$1,000 Scholarships Awarded

The WCTA Scholarship Committee recently reviewed 17 applications from area high school seniors. Eight students including Tarrin Mickelson, Max Pajari, Tarah Cleveland, Brett Brockpahler, Katianne Brockpahler, Natasha Maninga, Jasmine Titcomb and Tareyn Stomberg were awarded scholarships from WCTA. The scholarships were each valued at \$1,000.

Area high school seniors are invited every year to apply for the WCTA scholarship. Applying for a scholarship is very easy to do. The student can complete the entire scholarship application online, print them, and have them signed by their guidance counselor. This is the sixth year with the online format, which has been really helpful with keeping the applicants consistent and anonymous. The applicants choose from three or four topics for consideration when writing their essay. The scholarship committee reviews applicants based on their essay and community involvement. The scholarship's purpose is to recognize students who have contributed to the quality of life in the communities they live in and to assist them in their educational pursuits.

Only students whose parents or legal guardians are cooperative members at the time of the application are eligible to apply. Children of West Central Telephone's employees or board members are not eligible.


