66th Annual Meeting Highlights

The 66th annual meeting was May 9 at the Sebeka High School Auditorium. Board president Bruce Kinnunen talked about the completion of our fiber-to-the-home network. Our network now includes 1,499 route miles of fiber throughout our 602 square mile area. He mentioned our national Gig-Capable certification and our new Honeywell line of home security and automation services. He demonstrated the Amazon Tap, asking Alexa for the Wolf Lake forecast. If you aren't familiar with the Amazon Tap, it's definitely worth checking out!

Controller Jennifer Grewe discussed the financial statements. General Manager Chad Bullock discussed regulatory reform, revenue streams and strategic partnerships. Jason Dale, CEO of Cooperative Network Services, gave his perspective of our industry under this new era of regulatory reform. Kinnunen also

announced that \$357,173 capital credits will be paid out to members this year.

Eight \$1,000 Scholarships Awarded

We recently reviewed applications from area high school seniors. The committee awarded eight students \$1,000 scholarships each.
